More than 500,000 women die of cardiovascular disease each year, exceeding the number of deaths in men and the next seven causes of death in women combined. This translates into approximately one death every minute. Coronary artery disease (CAD) which includes coronary atherosclerotic disease, myocardial infarction (MI), acute coronary syndrome, and angina is the most prevalent form of cardiovascular disease and is the largest subset of this mortality. An estimated 16.3 million Americans 20 years of age and older have CAD, and the overall CAD prevalence is 7 percent in adults in the United States (8.3 for men, 6.1 for women). The prevalence of CAD is higher in men than in women across different age groups until they reach 75 years of age, giving the perception that CAD is a male-specific disease. This report focuses on women because of the differences in clinical presentation and coronary anatomy, which affect the treatment options for CAD.
