At thirty-one years old, I'd been locked up in jail or prison, driven into detox and addiction treatment, or lost on the streets for most of my adult life. From the opening chapter, Tim White's memoir AT THE END OF THE ROAD: ONE MANS JOURNEY FROM CHAOS TO CLARITY takes a gritty, honest look at the realities of drug and alcohol addiction and the mind of an addict. It asks hard questions: Can a person change? Can someone move beyond a tough childhood? Or, is it sometimes too late? Tim White's childhood was no easy road to travel. As his mother gave birth in a Florida hospital to her fourth son, born of her third marriage, his father battled an addiction to heroin in a German...
