The last Redwall novel published during Brian Jacques's lifetime (followed only by the posthumous *The Rogue Crew*), this adventure for readers 9 and up is one of the chronicles' most unforgettable. Vilaya the Sable Quean, devious ruler of hordes of vermin, intends to conquer Redwall Abbey, and when the Dibbuns at the abbey begin to go missing, her plan is revealed. Will the creatures of Redwall risk their home and all of Mossflower Wood to save their precious young ones? Perhaps Buckler the hare, Blademaster of the Long Patrol, can save the day, especially since he has a score of his own to settle. At the same time, Vilaya may have her hands full, as the Dibbuns of Redwall are not as helpless as they appear. "Life's been peaceful for Redwall's diverse woodland creatures.
