



Mamaind Stress: The Need for Strata

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Dimensions: 8.8in. x 6.0in. x 0.4in. Stress plays an important role in the phonology, morphology, and syntax of Mamaind. The author uses the current theories of metrical and lexical phonology to analyze this stress system. It is demonstrated that a typical application of metrical rules alone will not predict stress correctly. Instead, Mamaind must make use of multiple strata in order for stress placement to be predicted. Note: The Mamaind, a language of Brazil is also known as Northern Nambikura (Ethnologue, 15th Ed. 2005)

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
